Links to Literacy

A multi-sensory program designed to improve decoding skills through the strengthening of sound blending, segmentation, and discrimination. Orton-Gillingham based strategies will address sound-letter association (beginning/ending blends), syllable types and spelling rules. Proficiency in these skills is associated with improved auditory processing, reading and spelling ability. The development of these skills will be addressed through individual and group instruction/intervention designed to target goals. Each session will include individual instruction using evidence-based software programs. A parent component is also built into this program.
